20THINTERNATIONAL LYRICAL AND INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC COMPETITION OF LES CORTS











The 20th International Lyrical and Instrumental Music Competition of les Corts, in Barcelona.

(CIM Les Corts) organised by Barcelona City Council -District of Les Corts, together with A Tempo Musical Studies Centre and the Ass. Per l'Altre Cor Cremat-Ajut al quart món and Voce, Música & Òpera, aims to:

- > stimulate and support the music careers of young people
- > encourage musical interpretation, as well as the diffusion of classical music starting from the youngest generations
- > establish a new musical diffusion cultural frame in les Corts.

RULES

- The competition is open to all classical music performers of all nationalities who will be between 18 and 30 years old on 31 December 2024.
- **7** The contest includes two categories:
 - > Instrumental: **Soloists**, with or without piano, **and chamber accompaniment**, up to a maximum of five members (in which case, every individual member has to meet the conditions in section 1 of these rules).
 - > Soloist: **Lyrical Soloists**. The competition organisers provide piano accompaniment for the Lyrical Soloists category.
- The contest consists of three phases:

> Selection Phase

At Centre Cívic Josep Ma Trias i Peitx (lyrical category) and at A Tempo Musical Studies Centre (instrumental category). Those registered will take part in an audition, on the morning of 11 March (instrumental category) and 12 March (lyrical category), as long as the number of participants makes it possible. The repertoire interpreted will be chosen freely among the titles provided on the registration form, never exceeding 10 minutes and two music pieces. The objective is to choose 16 candidates (8 from each category), who will move on to the concert phase.

> Concert Phase

At Centre Civic Can Deu

Each selected candidate will give a performance, no longer than 15 minutes, on the **afternoon** of **13 March** (instrumental category), and **14 March** (lyrical category). The aim of this phase is to choose 8 candidates (4 from each category), who will move on to the final phase.

> Final phase

At **Axa Auditorium**

Finalists will have a 10 minutes audition, on **16 March** of 2024, on the **afternoon**, according to the jury's selection, based on the pieces included on the registration form. The jury's verdict and the awards ceremony will take place on the same day.

- Each candidate or group will present a free program of **45 minutes**, which will have to be indicated in the registration form. In the **singing** category, to qualify for the Victoria de los Ángeles award, there must be a minimum of **2 lied**. In the instrumental category to qualify for the Xavier Montsalvatge award, there must be a minimun of one piece from the composer. In the instrumental category, to qualify for the Brotons i Mercadal award, there must be a minimun of one piece from Brotons i Mercadal publishing house.
- The date and the order in which they will perform in the selection phase will be available for candidates from 13 March 2024 at ajuntament.barcelona.cat/lescorts and also at cimbarcelona.com
- Those registered agree to take part in all the phases, and also in the concerts which they might be appointed to by the organising committee.
- Finalists and winners will not be able to participate in the next competition in the same category.

- The jury may interrupt the performances during the selection phase if appropriate. The jury's decisions will be final, and the candidates will not communicate with its members. The jury reserves the right to declare the award null and void, and to select a smaller number of finalists.
- Registering in the competition means the acceptance of these rules. Any unforeseen matter will be decided on by common agreement reached by the organising committee.
- The winners agree to mention this award in their Artistic CV.

The final date for registration is **1 March 2024** including the day.

AUDIENCE AWARD

In Memoriam Oroitz Maiz Morea (1984-2015)

Chosen by the audience during the final phase at the Axa Auditorium; all the finalists will be eligible. The prize includes a performance at the closing concert of the Festa Major which will take place on October 2024 at Auditori AXA.

SPECIAL AWARD

Photographic book made in studio by Antoni Bofill awarded to the winners in each category.

The winners or finalists will be proposed for participation in the following music programmes:

- Primer Palau 2025 Prize. A finalist in the singing category and a finalist in the instrumental category will be invited by the CIM jury to present themselves preferentially in the selection stage of El Primer Palau 2025, organized by the Palau de la Música Catalana, and to be chosen to participate in their cycle.
- Victoria de los Ángeles Special Prize, from the Victoria de los Ángeles Foundation. The prize consists of a scholarship to take part in the Festival's master classes and the possibility of performing as a support act (Life New Artists) at the Life Victoria Festival. The prize will be open to participants in the singing category who have presented at least two Lieds during the competition and the final stage which must be specified on the registration form.
- Xavier Montsalvatge Award awarded by the Association Xavier Montsalvatge Composer, which offers a concert within the Lied Festival Victoria de los Ángeles (LIFE Victoria '24) in which a piece by X. Montsalvatge will have to be played. The finalists of the instrumental category, soloists or chamber will qualify for this award.

- ESTA Spain Award, national branch of European String Techers Association, awarded to an individual string finalist in the instrumental category. It consists of one year of free membership in ESTA Spain, which includes access to all conferences, discounts with sponsors, networking with string professors, etc, and presentation of a mute awarded by Wmutes.
- ACIMC Award, Catalan Association of Classical Music Performers, awarded to a finalist in the instrumental category and/or vocal category.
 It consists of one year of free membership in ACIMC, including all its services.
- Brotons i Mercadal Award, awarded to an individual finalist in the instrumental category, consisting of two lots of scores from the Brotons&Mercadal publishing house worth $300 \in$ and $200 \in$.

To access this prize it is necessary to include **a piece** from the publisher on the registration form.

- Jardí dels Tarongers Prize, from the Casa Bartomeu, for finalists in the instrumental category. This consists of a concert within the 2025 autumn season at the Casa Bartomeu, in Barcelona.
- Clàssica a les Corts Prize, awarded to one of the finalists of the instrumental and singing category. This consists of a concert within the 2024-2025 Clàssica season, at the Josep Maria Trias i Peitx Civic Centre, in Barcelona.
- Les Veus del Monestir Prize, awarded to one of the finalists in the singing category. This consists of a concert organised as part of the Les Veus del Monestir lyrical cycle, at the Monestir de Pedralbes 2025, in Barcelona.


